Sample Dialectical Journal Entries

Your dialectical journal entries should confirm that you understand what you're reading. Keeping this journal will authenticate that you are engaged with the text. There are two ways to develop your Dialectical Journal: #1: You will first annotate text that seems significant, powerful, thought provoking or puzzling like the following examples:

Dialectical Journal - ms. d's English and Research Class

Here is an example of a dialectical journal entry for hyperbole: Quote from Catcher in the Rye: "You never saw anyone nod as much in your life as old Spencer did" (Salinger 9). Mrs. Rogers' Commentary on this quote: From the beginning, we can tell that Holden is uncomfortable inside the Spencers' home. He knows that he has been expelled from his high-end private school, and this teacher has asked to see him before he leaves.

Dialectical Journal Entry Example - Pre-AP English I--John ...

In a true dialectic fashion, the journal should mirror your back-and-forth reasoning process. Journal length will vary with your teacher and assignment, but the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory suggests at least one entry for every 40 pages of reading.

DIALECTICAL JOURNAL

The dialectical journal will also be a requirement for any summative reassessments. In other words, if you do not have an up-to-date journal, you cannot retest. Your journal should be divided into three columns, with each corresponding to a major thematic idea from the novel (civilization vs. savagery; loss of innocence; innate evil in all humans).
