Denitrification occurs under anoxic conditions such as wetlands where NO₃ is reduced to various gaseous forms. The N cycle is largely controlled by bacteria, hence the rate of N cycling is dependent upon factors such as soil moisture, temperature, pH, etc. NO₃ is the end-product of aerobic N decomposition and is always dissolved and mobile.

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
